
Deep-Set Eyes

Look for this shape when the brow bone appears more noticeable due to the deep setting of the eyes. You can draw attention to the magnetic quality of these eyes while bringing the visibility of the lids forward by avoiding dark shades in the crease.

- Highlighter shade: Apply to the eyelid and along the inner corner of lower lashes and to brow bone.
- Midtone shade: Bring the color up above the crease and sweep it across the brow bone.
- 3. Accent shade: Apply to the outer corner of the upper lashline, then up onto the corner of the brow bone. Sweep the accent shade underneath the lower lashline for definition.
- Eyeliner: Glide a thin line along upper and lower lashline, thickening the line slightly on outer two-thirds of lid. Soften with the Eyeliner/Eyebrow Brush, if desired.
- 5. Mascara: Apply to upper and lower lashes.
